Actor Bio:

Robyn has performed as a professional singer and actress in New York City for more than fifteen years. She is the Co-Founder of the Drama Desk and Obie award-winning Off-Broadway theatre company, Transport Group. For the six years she served as Founding Executive Director, she produced and starred in Transport Group productions for which the company received the 2007 Drama Desk and Obie awards for its breadth of vision and presentation of challenging productions and two Drama Desk award nominations for Outstanding Musical (THE AUDIENCE and for Outstanding revival of a musical (FIRST LADY SUITE -- in which she portrayed Jacqueline Kennedy alongside an unforgettable cast including Audra McDonald). Since its inception, Transport Group has received more than 22 Drama Desk nominations and awards from American Theatre Wing and Drama League.

Other career highlights in New York City include Kayla in NORMAL, Maria Bratislava in EPHEMERA at Ariel Tepper's Summer Play Festival, at Joe's Pub in her one-woman show OLD FASHIONED GIRL, and playing Jacqueline Kennedy in Michael John LaChiusa's FIRST LADY SUITE as part of the New York Historical Society's exhibit on First Ladies alongside Mary Testa, Julia Murney, Judy Blazer, Donna Lynne Champlin, Audra McDonald and Mary Beth Piel.

In 2006 she left her work in New York City to create the NORMAL In Schools program and nonprofit organization. Since then, Ms. Hussa has served as Founding Executive Director of NIS and Co-Director of the musical NOR*MAL. For her work on this effort she received the 2010 Champion in Women's Health award from Ms. Sue Ann Thompson and the Wisconsin Women's Health Foundation and she is a regular Keynote presenter at arts, medical, educational conferences nationwide.

She is the author of her book: Healthy Selfitude and of the Normal Learning blog and Eating Disorders in Schools blog for Gurze Publishing.

Hussa recently completed creating the documentary film: SPEAKING OUT ABOUT ED for the NORMAL In Schools nonprofit, which is the result of five years of her research while entrenched in schools, hospitals and in private homes interviewing top researchers to reveal the facts surrounding the eating disorders and the obesity epidemic in our nation.

Robyn holds an MFA-Acting from the University of Virginia, is a member of the three professional acting unions (AEA, AFTRA, SAG), the Academy for Eating Disorders, The International Association for Eating Disorders Professionals, Drama League, and is a Registered Yoga Teacher with the Yoga Alliance. She lives in New York City where she manages the NIS nonprofit, teaches meditation and mindfulness to patients in recovery and their families, and produces various other projects with her production company White Elephant Enterprises; including the NORMAL Family documentary and The Walking Hospital, by Tim Farrell, which will be featured in New York's Hell's Kitchen Film Festival in September 2011.
